



# Recommendation Build local government capacity














### **NOTED GAINS**

- Adopted first comprehensive plan update in over
   30 years
- Received \$1.5 million from Rebuild Illinois:
   Shovel Ready Sites
- Crafted strategies for filing empty grocery store building with new tenant
- Streamlined internal process for selection of contractors
- Created new role of grant coordinator
- Received \$400,000 grant to demolish vacant buildings
- Received additional funding to redesign two corridors.

### **NOTED GAINS**

- Received \$750,000 in grants for comp plan priorities
- Completed pavement management program
- Progress on regional multi-use path
- Initiated water loss audit
- Performed targeted zoning code updates
- Completed engineering for intersection improvements and two playgrounds Conducted PHASE 1 for vacant and underutilized parcels
- Launched Rock the Block through Habitat for Humanity

### Resource | Opportunity | Impact ROI Program

Building municipal capacity in grant readiness to move from planning to project.

- 1. **Establish consensus** on priority transportation projects
- 2. **Identify** next steps for implementation
- 3. **Build** the capacity of the municipality to apply for and manage funding

completed grant applications

6 months/250 staff hrs (each) 3-4 municipalities

#### **Capacity Building Collaborative**

Helping a cohort pursue shared goals across jurisdictional boundaries that complements their respective strengths and competitive advantages.

- 1. **Build** strong relationships with and between the consortium municipalities
- 2. **Explore and develop** informed perspective of shared challenge
- 3. **Foster collaboration** to address the shared challenge in their respective communities

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

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### **INSIGHTS**

CMAP's Community Cohort Evaluation Tool is a foundational assessment of capacity. It does not indicate government effectiveness

Community selection process must be probing and deliberate

When getting to know the community in the first phase, the program benefited from CMAP staff attending municipal internal staff meetings in its entirety

When working with local governments around capacity building, CMAP must expect and be able to rapidly gain expertise in areas beyond CMAP purview



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Working in municipalities with consultants on retainer provides challenges to ensure capacity building of the local government office

Requirements for grant funding can present unintended barriers for high-need, low-resource communities

Administration change and staff turnover is detrimental to progress and institutional knowledge transfers
